# Professor Dennis Driscoll for Singapore CSR & Corporate Governance, July 2012



- Given training on on CSR/Corporate Governance to more than 500 companies in Europe and in Emerging Markets, especially in China, and, more recently, in Africa and the Middle East.
- Developing a multi-language (English, Arabic, Chinese, Spanish) PowerPoint training Programme of approximately 30 hour-long presentations involving the complete range of CSR issues: from labour issues to human rights issues to environmental concerns, and from corporate philanthropy to corporate governance to ethical business practices such as avoiding corrupt business payments.
- The training programme can be used by multinational companies with their supply chain partners as well as by Governments for their civil servants, and by NGOs. It can also be used to train journalists in CSR issues.

## CV HIGHLIGHTS

Professor Dennis Driscoll teaches Corporate Social Responsibility at the National University of Ireland (Galway). Formerly, he also taught International Law and International Human Rights. He is one of the pioneers in Europe in the teaching of Corporate Social Responsibility.

He has taught at the University of Edinburgh, Cornell University, and Harvard University, where, from 1985-1991, he was the Chairman of Harvard's Seminar Series on *'Media Coverage of International Affairs'*. He is a Co-Founder of the Irish Centre for Human Rights, and he was for many years the President of the Irish Branch of the International Law Association.

From 2004-2005, he was the Raoul Wallenberg Institute Visiting Professor of Human Rights at Peking University Law School, the first Professor of Human Rights in the history of China.

He was the Dean of the School of Law at the National University of Ireland (Galway), from 1985-1991, and he was the Legal Adviser to the Irish Foreign Ministry from 1994-1995. He has also been legal counsel to a number of other governments and international organisations.

Earlier, he was the Irish expert to the Council of Europe committee which dealt with consciousness-raising in Europe about human rights issues. During that time, amongst other tasks, the committee promoted educational materials about human rights for the police, for prison staff, for the medical profession and for journalists.

Dennis Driscoll was the director of a number of programmes at the School of Law dealing with the legal problems of multinational companies including the School's annual *Workshop on the Legal Problems of Multinational Companies*.

In 1997 the President of the National University of Ireland (Galway) created an Award for outstanding contribution to the success of the university. Dennis Driscoll was the first academic ever to be honoured by receipt of the Award.

He now devotes much of his time to giving training to companies on Corporate Social Responsibility and Corporate Governance. He is the author of the forthcoming study, *Comparative Corporate Governance*.
